Young Harris Basketball... the Inside Story

ICL is delighted to offer an inside peek at our Young Harris Basketball teams just in time for the upcoming season which begins on November 12th. Led by men's coach Jeremy Currier, and women's coach Lindsey Huffman, this four session offering promises to be both informative and enjoyable. The coaches will discuss basic rules and recent rule changes, their own strategies and how they will apply them. You will also get an early glimpse into the current rosters of players. If you are a season ticket holder, one who is soon to be or just an interested fan, you will not want to miss getting the inside scoop from these very talented coaches! Attendance for classes will be limited to 18 in the ICL Classroom but will be simulcast over Zoom.

Coach Jeremy Currier is entering his third season as head coach of the Young Harris Mountain Lions. In previous seasons, his teams have shown improvement in both individual and team stats. Prior to his arrival at Young Harris, Currier coached for 11 years at Pfeiffer University, and Daniel Webster College. He holds a bachelor's degree in Sports Management from Endicott College, and a Masters in Leadership from Pfeiffer University.

Coach Lindsey Huffman will lead the Lady Mountain Lions for her second year, following 7 successful seasons as head coach at Reinhardt College in Waleska, Georgia. She is the first Women's coach to be named Coach of the Year in the Peach Belt Conference from Young Harris College. Huffman is a native of Woodstock, Georgia and holds a bachelor's degree in Physical Education and master's degree in Education from the University of North Georgia.
